One of the region's most popular and oldest cycling events, and named 'One of Four Classic Rides in the Nation' by *Bicycling Magazine*, the CHILLY HILLY is a 33-mile recreational ride circumnavigating Bainbridge Island with over 3,500 expected participants.

The event and Finish Line Festival with chili feed will benefit local Bainbridge Island charities - including Island Girl Scouts, Fort Ward Neighborhood Association, and Cascade Bicycle Club's advocacy and education programs.
