GENERAL:

Photographs must have a connection to bicycling. This will usually be expressed by the image of a bicycle or bicycling equipment. As an example, generic scenes incidentally taken on a bicycle trip would not be acceptable. All entries will be displayed at the 2008 Group Health Seattle International Bicycle Expo, March 8 - 9 at Cruise Terminal 30.

JUDGING:

Entries will be judged on the basis of content, composition and creativity.

PRIZES:

Commemorative awards for top three places in each category and a People's choice award chosen by the Expo visitors. Two Honorable mentions will also be awarded in each category.

WHO MAY ENTER AND FEES:

Open to all amateur photographers. There is no limit to the number of entries each person may submit. The entry fee is \$5.00 for the first photo entered and \$1.00 for each additional entry. Photos submitted from past contests will be disqualified.

PREPARING YOUR ENTRY:

Maximum print size is 8x12. Print must be flush mounted on an 11x14 white mat, with no frame or other mounting. To flush mount, use an 11x14 white mount board and place the print on top of the mat using tacky glue, craft glue for pictures, or medical tape. Attach a completed entry form on reverse. A separate form must be submitted for each entry. Feel free to copy this original. Correct fees must accompany each entry. Fees may be submitted by cash, check or money order (no credit cards) made to Cascade Bicycle Club.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES:

Photographs may be submitted in person or by mail. Receiving locations for delivery are:
