Ride **SMART** Tips

Stay alert—watch for obstacles, other cars, and other riders.

Move off the road when stopping —pull completely off the road to let cars and riders pass; do not block driveways or intersections.

Act like a car —obey all traffic laws and stop at stop signs

Retain space between yourself and others —leave enough room to dodge obstacles.

Tell others when passing and pass on left.
Remember, Single File is Safer!

- √ Ride single file along narrow stretches. Never more than two abreast.
- √ Do not wear headphones - it's against the law.
- √ Use voice and hand signals before stopping or turning.
- √ Make sure your bike is in good working order & inflate your tires.
- √ Only use restrooms and sanicans provided at rest stops.
- √ Be courteous to the Bainbridge Island Community -- we want to be invited back!
- √ Be prepared for rain or shine - we'll be there regardless!



THE SEASON FINALE RIDE!

Autumn has arrived. The morning air is crisp and the leaves are turning shades of gold and scarlet. Some of you are thinking of calling it a bicycling season and staring at the tube until next spring. **NO WAY!** On Sunday, October 4, Cascade Bicycle Club presents the 17th Annual Kitsap Color Classic, our season finale. Take an autumn ride guaranteed to invigorate all of your senses. Pedal along the gorgeous Kitsap Peninsula and check out our three loops that wind through some of the best riding country in the State! Friendly communities and terrific fall scenery make this a fun, must do event.

THE RIDE LOOPS

These loops are great for recreational riders, yet can be challenging to ride hard and fast (yup, that means a few hills).

Indianola Loop	14 miles	Some hills, mostly rolling
Hansville Loop	25 miles	Some hills, one steep
Poulsbo/Port Gamble Loop	36 miles	Some hills, mostly rolling

Hansville/Indianola	33 miles
Poulsbo/Indianola	43 miles
Hansville/Poulsbo	55 miles
Hansville/Poulsbo/Indianola	64 miles

REGISTRATION

Pre-registration online for an Edmonds start is **\$27** (includes round-trip ferry fare); for a Kingston start, it's **\$20** (no ferry fare included). After **Sept. 30**, registration is at the start line only. In Edmonds, day-of-ride registration is **\$35** and it's open from 7:30 AM to 10 AM. In Kingston, it's **\$28** and it's open from 9 AM to 11AM. Cascade members receive a \$5 discount. **No confirmations will be sent!** Packet pickup is day-of-the-ride **ONLY** at the start line(s).

START LINES & COURSE HOURS

Kingston: Start line and day-of-ride registration at the Kitsap Bank located at the corner of Hwy 104 and Hansville Rd., (also the food stop location).

Open 9 AM to 11 AM.

Edmonds: Start line and day-of-ride registration is at the Masonic Temple on Dayton St. between 5th and 6th. Open 7:30 AM to 10 AM.

Ferry Schedule: 8:40, 9:20 and 10:10 AM. Your KCC bib is your ticket to ride one of these ferries—**fees for other ferry times are not covered. Please remove bike cleats before walking upstairs on the ferries.**

The schedule is subject to change. Call 888-808-7977 to confirm times.

Course Hours: 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

Safety vehicles are identified with Cascade Bicycle Club signs. **For day-of-ride emergencies call (206) 841-9665**, answered live at the communications center. Food stops will have various food items from one or more of the four major food groups (no, chocolate isn't a major food group!). So take a break and enjoy waterfront views against a backdrop of the Olympic Mountains.

Besides receiving lots of information and a newsletter listing the most comprehensive rides program in the area, Cascade Bicycle Club members receive a \$5 discount on this event. If you join when you register, you'll receive the discount. Kitsap Color Classic 2009 RELEASE AGREEMENT

- In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and by signing this Release for myself (or for the participant if the participant is under 18) I agree to RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, and INDEMNIFY Cascade Bicycle Club and all its sponsors, their respective officers, agents, members, employees and volunteers and any and all Countries, States, Departments of Transportation, State Patrols, Counties, Townships and Cities through which this Event may pass, and any other parties connected with this bicycle event including but not limited to elected and appointed officials and their employees for any injury, loss or damage suffered as a result of participation in this bicycle event or any activity associated with it, including injury, loss or damage caused by the NEGLIGENCE of any party.
- I understand that there are certain risks associated with bicycle riding, including the risk of serious personal injury or death, and I expressly agree to assume these risks. I understand the route chosen may be challenging, not necessarily the safest or easiest route, and that weather, road or traffic conditions may make this ride more difficult. I warrant that I am in proper physical condition to participate in this event, that I am a sufficiently competent cyclist to handle the road conditions, and that my bicycle is in safe operating condition.
- I understand that wearing a helmet that meets the CPSC, SNELL, ASTM or ANSI bicycle safety standards can minimize head injuries which may occur in a cycling accident, and that Cascade Bicycle Club requires all riders to wear helmets. I agree to wear a helmet while participating in this event and to follow the rules of the road and all applicable laws and safe bicycling practices. It is my sole responsibility to insure that my helmet meets CPSC, SNELL, ASTM or ANSI standards and to wear my helmet while participating in this event.
- If I resell or transfer my Registration or Ride Number, I agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY Cascade Bicycle Club for any injury, loss or damage suffered as a result of the participation of the individual using my Registration or Ride Number unless that individual also signs this Release Agreement.
- I give permission to Cascade Bicycle Club to use my image in any future Club materials should it appear in photos taken during this Event.
- I understand that this Release is also binding on my heirs and representatives. If I am signing on behalf of a minor, I accept full responsibility for all medical expenses incurred as a result of the minor's participation. I agree to HOLD HARMLESS and INDEMNIFY the entities named above for any claims brought on behalf of the minor.
- By registering, I agree to read and familiarize myself with the information in the registration materials and follow the procedures and rules. I will fill out credit card information or include check or money order (US Funds) payable to Cascade Bicycle Club.
- Any legal action that may arise from my participation in this event will be handled in the state of Washington according to Washington State law.
- Cascade Bicycle Club reserves the right to remove any participating rider from this event if said rider is deemed by an authorized Club agent to be endangering him/herself or other participants, or is riding illegally as defined by Washington State traffic law. Notwithstanding this clause, Cascade Bicycle Club is not responsible for cyclists not removed from the event for these or any other reason(s) and this clause shall in no way supersede, exempt participants from or otherwise nullify any other clause in this release agreement.
