What does the Cascade Bicycle Club Education Foundation do?

The Cascade Bicycle Club Education Foundation, a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, promotes bicycling safety, skills, and education in the interest of creating a better community through bicycling. Kids participate in assemblies run by Sprocket Hero, our masked safety crusader, while others ride through our bike safety rodeo courses. Through safety and skills programs for kids, the WRQ Bike to Work Month and Commute Challenge, Regional Routes and Safe Routes to Schools programs, and low-cost helmet sales and donations for all ages, we provide a variety of educational opportunities and family programs for the local community. Please help us educate future STP riders, bike commuters, and recreational cyclists as well as the community.

What kinds of programs does my fundraising support?

- \$50 buys **10 bicycle helmets** for needy kids
- \$100 pays for "**Sprocket Hero**" safety assemblies for 500 kids.
- \$250 prints **5000 safety brochures**
- \$500 supports participation of **5000 kids in bicycle safety rodeos**
- \$1000 helps us run **5 "Tips for Riding in Traffic" courses** for groups of adults
- \$2500 establishes "**Safe Routes to Schools**" programs in two elementary or middle schools and supports their participation in "**Bike to Work/School Day**"
- \$5000 allows us to support the "**Basics of Bicycling**" bike safety education curriculum in one district, for one year, **for 5000 students**.
- Donations of any size support our efforts to **educate politicians and transportation planners** about bicycle-friendly facilities and needed infrastructure.
